### What is Operation Round Up®?

Operation Round Up® is a voluntary program that does just what the name implies. Each month we will “round up” the electric bills of participating members to the next highest dollar. For Example, a member’s monthly bill of \$150.75 would automatically be rounded up to \$151.00, with the additional 25 cents going to the Operation Round Up Fund. Donations are tax deductible.

### How do I participate?

Participation in Operation Round Up is strictly voluntary. You can sign up by sending back the attached mailer with your payment, or you can stop in or call and ask to be included in the Operation Round Up® program.

### How much will it cost members?

The average contribution per member is about 50 cents per month or \$6.00 per year. With this small change, thousands of dollars can be generated and will mean a big difference to the people in our service area.

### Where will the money go?

All Operation Round Up donations are placed in a trust administered by an independent Board of Directors. The Board of Directors is made up of five Codington-Clark Electric board members who serve on the board on a voluntary basis. It is the responsibility of the Board to receive, evaluate all requests and to decide how to distribute the funds. The trust fund is used for charitable projects and causes throughout the service area.

Together, by giving a few cents a month, Codington-Clark Electric members can make a big impact on life in our area!

### Who is eligible for funds?

The funds are available to help any charitable projects for organizations, groups, families, or individuals within the service territory of Codington-Clark Electric. No funds shall in any way be used to support any candidate for political office or for any political purpose.

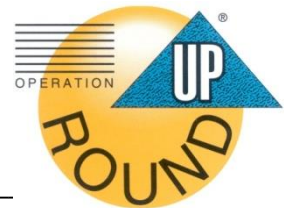
### How do I apply for funds?
